



# **LED Lightbar Installation:**



Put on safety glasses. Using a trim clip removal tool gently remove the center dash control center (FIG 1)



Disconnect any wiring harnesses and set control panel aside. (FIG 2)






Remove the center screw using a Phillips head screwdriver and set aside. (FIG 3)



Gently pry out the window control panel from the top and work your way down. (FIG 4)



Tilt panel away enough to access the 12v socket connection. Squeeze the blue tab and disconnect it. (FIG 5)



Connect the white connector to the original plug you just disconnected in FIG5. Connect the gray connector back into the 12v socket. (FIG 6)



Open the glove box and disconnect the strut on the side by sliding it towards the top of the glove box. (FIG 7)





Push up on the glove box stop, tilt glovebox down, remove it and set aside. (FIG8) Now, route the new harness through the dash and out behind the



Using a trim tool gently pry up on the dash speaker cover and remove it. (FIG 10)



glove box. (FIG 9) You may now replace all of the center dash parts in the reverse order of removal.

Do not re-install the glove box yet.



Using a trim tool gently remove the A-pillar grab handle covers. (FIG 11)



Remove the two bolts using a 10mm socket. (FIG 12) Remove handle and set it aside.





Unlatch and open the soft top or remove hard top front panels. Remove the felt padding on top of the brackets hardware. (FIG 13)



Remove the hardware using a T-40 Torx socket and loosely install the supplied brackets as shown. (FIG 14)



NOTE THAT THE BRACKET IS NOT SYMMETRIC. THE SLOTS ON THE BRACKETS ARE 2 DIFFERENT SIZES. THE LARGER HOLES MUST BE USED ON THE TOP.



Tilt the driver side light bar into place, careful not to knock off the smaller end gasket. (FIG 15) Loosely attach the light bar to the bracket using the supplied T-40 torx bolts. Next, route the



passenger side light bar up and over the rear view mirror, careful not to knock off the smaller end gasket and loosely attach the light bar to the bracket using the supplied T-40 torx bolts. (FIG 16)



Now, route the wiring harness as shown down the A-pillar along side of the factory wiring. (FIG 17)



Fish the harness down through the dash to behind the glove box. (FIG 18)



Using a small flat blade screwdriver connect the light bars harness to the power tap harness. (FIG 19) You may now reinstall the glove box in the reverse order.



Re-install the grab handle taking care not to pinch any wires. (FIG 20)

Also, Re-install the speaker cover.



Now push the light brackets forward until they rest against the plastic trim. (FIG 21) You may now tighten the factory T-40 screws. Some adjustment may be necessary to re-align the brackets to your top latches.



Finally, push up on the light bar and tighten the T-40 screws from bracket to light bar. (FIG 22)

NOTE: DO NOT exceed 25 ft. lbs of torque. Installation is now complete.



With the light bar finally in place, install the cross brace using the supplied T-40 torx bolts. Use provided cable ties to attach wire to cross brace and cut excess cable tie with side cutters.



Observe location of the 3 Position Switch. See above for the various settings based on rocker switch position.

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
