Directions:

Prepare by cleaning the damaged area with isopropyl alcohol. Trim any loose threads. Cut patch with rounded corners to overlap damaged area by at least 1"

Apply:

Peel off backing and apply to damaged area. Apply pressure from center out to eliminate air bubbles. For large holes, apply matching patch to opposite side of material. Adhesive will continue to strengthen over time.

In the event of an unrepairable soft top:
