

## TENT ASSEMBLY - STEP 1

Put on safety glasses. Unpack all of the tent bed accessories. (Fig 1) Locate the two types of fiber glass rods. (D. & C.) Rod (C.) will have blue color coded tips. (Fig 2)



Lay the tent on the ground. Load rod (C.) with color coded blue tips first into the sleeve that runs parallel across the tent. Load rods (D.) through the sleeves of the tent which runs criss cross. (Fig 3) Attach each rod to the plastic clips as shown. (Fig 4)

## STEP 3

FIG 5



Place the rain fly cover over the tent and attach each quick release buckle. (Fig 5)

## STEP 4

Open the tailgate of the vehicle and lift the tent into the bed. Keep the door of the tent toward the end of the bed. (Fig 6)



## STEP 5



Use the hooks on the tent around the chassis. The hook length can be adjusted as needed. (Fig 7)  
**Please Note:** One hook is located at each corner of the bed to be secured between the tailgate and the bed floor. (Fig 8)

## STEP 6

Attach the light strip to the inside of the tent using the velcro straps. Unzip the opening to access the connector for the light strip. (Fig 9)  
There are two storage pouches on each side of the tent to utilize for storage.



## TENT DISASSEMBLY - STEP 1



Remove all of the attaching hooks and the rain fly cover. (Fig 1) Remove the lighting strip from inside the tent and lift the tent off of the bed. (Fig 2)

## STEP 2



Remove the poles by relieving them from the hooks and holes. (Fig 3) Take out the rods roll up the tent, rain fly cover, light strip and collect them together. Disassembly is now complete. Use the tent storage bag to package up all of your tent pieces. (Fig 4)

## REPLACING FIBERGLASS ROD

Spare rod X 1

Please loosen the elastic at end of the rod and pull out the broken rod when the fiberglass rod breaks, then replace the spare rod according to the following steps.

### 1 How to connect the fiberglass rods



Insert a elastic through the hole of the rod, and then insert another one until it is completely through.

### 2 Tie the ends of an elastic



Tie the ends of the elastic and pull it tight just like the image shown.

## **What is Covered:**

Subject to the terms, exclusions and limitations herein and with respect only to Lost Canyon branded accessories first sold in the United States, Lost Canyon warrants to the initial retail purchaser only that your Lost Canyon accessory shall be free of defects in material and workmanship: for a period of three (3) years from date of retail purchase.
